- * This item may require periodic tightening.















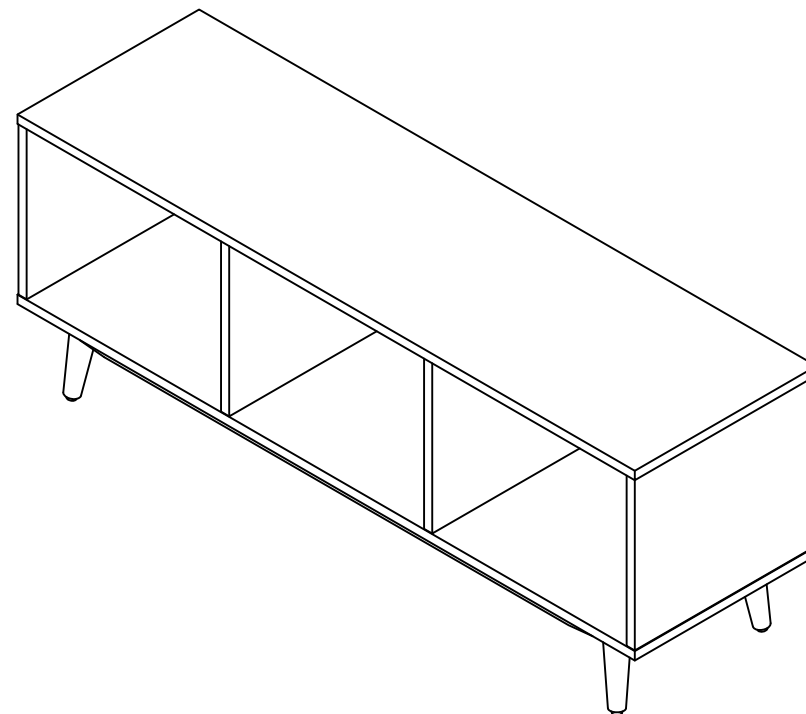



PREPARATION

<p>STEP 1 ATTACH LEFT AND RIGHT PANELS TO BACK UPPER AND LOWER FRAMES USING 1 1/4" ROUND HEAD SCREWS AND WOODEN DOWELS.</p>	<p>STEP 2 ATTACH CAMBOLTS TO TOP PANEL.</p>

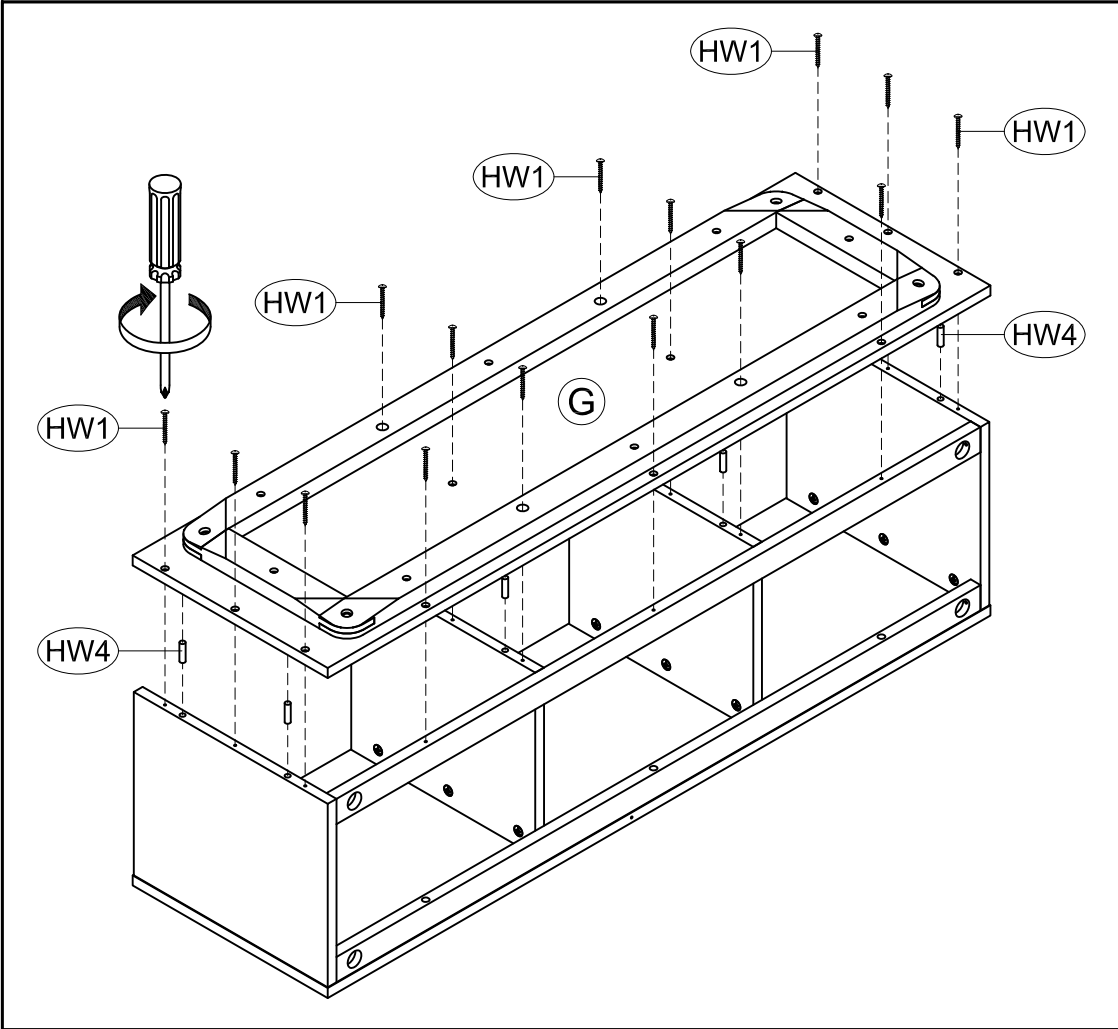
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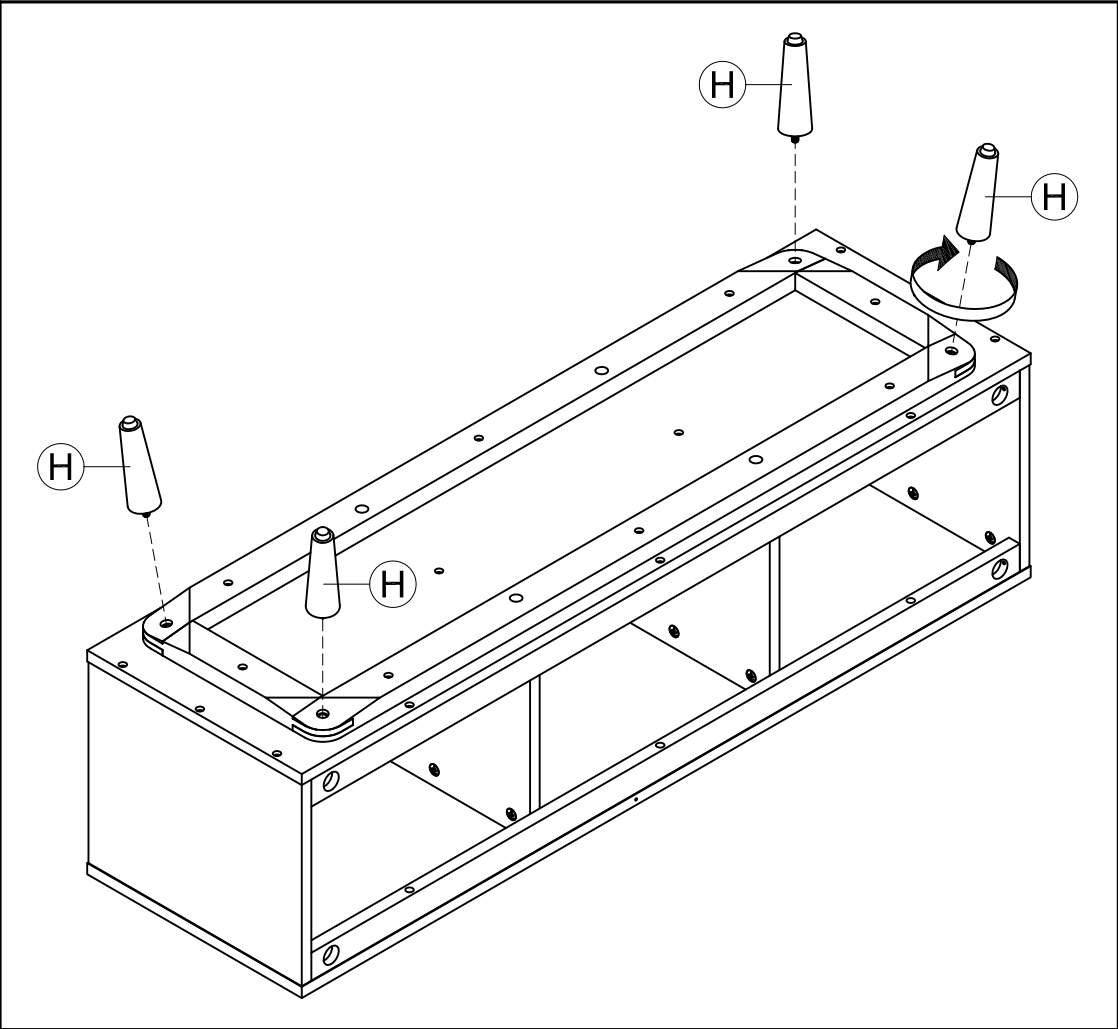

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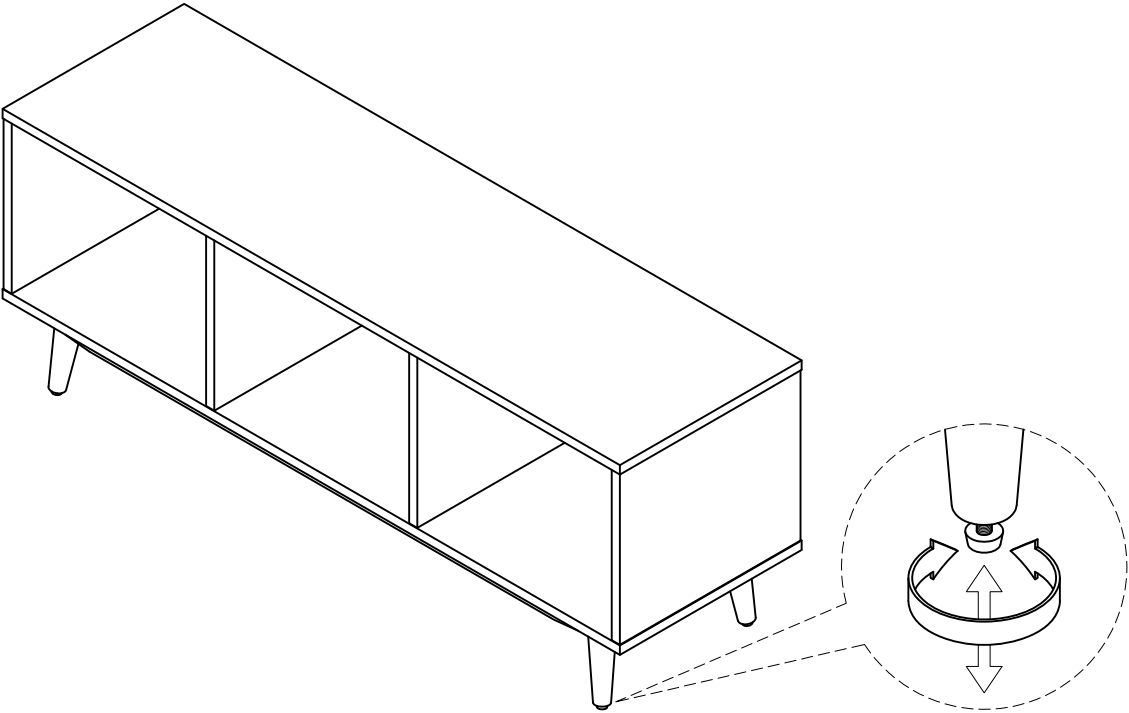

STEP 6 ATTACH LEGS TO UNIT, THEN TIGHTEN.

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STEP 7 ADJUST THE ADJUSTER BOLT THAT HAS ALREADY ASSEMBLED TO THE LEGS TO STABILIZE YOUR UNIT






Tip-Over Restraint

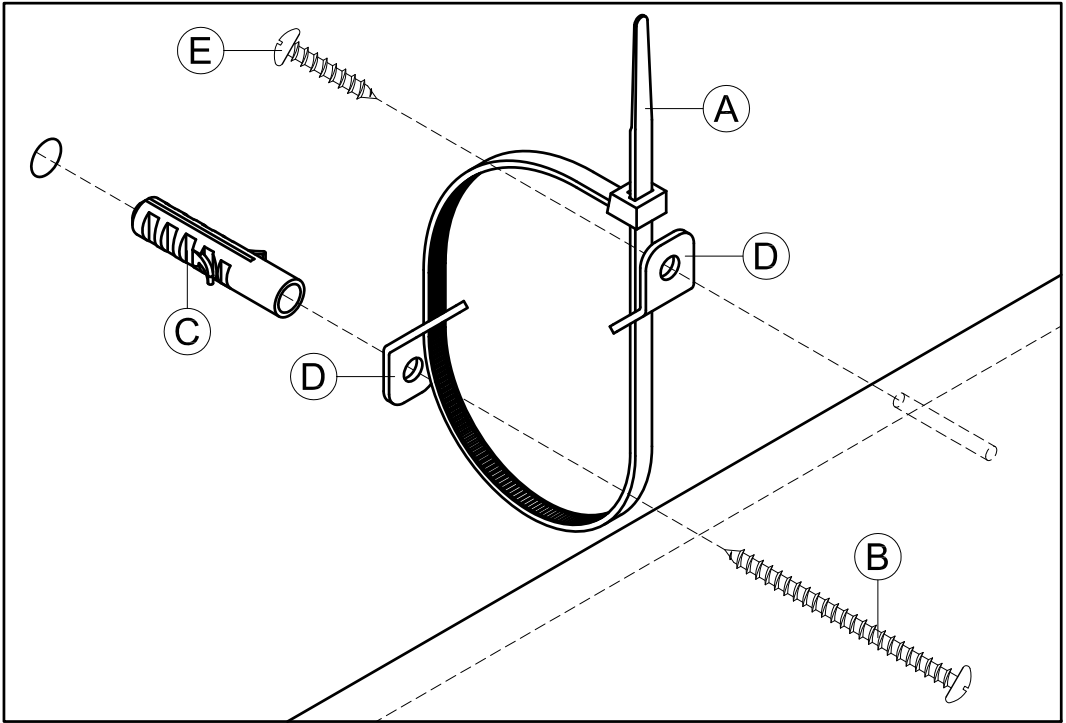
WARNING

Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from furniture tip over. To prevent tipover:

- * Install tipover restraint provided.
- * Place heaviest items in the lower drawers.
- * Unless specifically designed to accommodate, do not set TVs or other heavy objects on top of this product.
- * Never allow children to climb or hang on drawers, doors or shelves.
- * Never open more than one drawer at a time.
- * Do not defeat or remove the drawer interlock system.

Use of tipover restraints may only reduce, but not eliminate, the risk of tip over.

Assembly Steps :

1. Attach one mounting bracket "D" and secure to the back top edge of the furniture using the short screw "E".
2. Mark the location on the wall for mounting the second bracket "D". Create the appropriate sized hole in the wall and insert the plastic screw anchor "C". Secure the bracket to the wall using the long screw "B".
3. Place the furniture so the bracket on the back edge of unit is lined with the bracket on the wall.
4. Lace the end of the nylon strap "A" down through each of the bracket. Bring both ends together and slide the beaded end of the strap through the keyhole shaped slot on the other end. Pull down on the beaded end until it snap-locks into the keyhole.
5. Check to make sure the strap is securely laced and locked to the brackets.
6. Complete!
